5 Things You May Not Know About **Endometriosis**

 Severe pelvic or abdominal pain during your period, sex, or bowel movements is not normal.

If over-the-counter pain medications don't help and the pain disrupts everyday tasks for several days each month, it's time to get help.

2. Early diagnosis matters.

Left untreated, pain and symptoms can worsen. Talk to your VA health care provider about your symptoms and concerns.

3. About 1 in 10 women of reproductive age experience endometriosis.

Despite being common, it often takes years to diagnose due to lack of symptom awareness.

- 4. Endometriosis can make it more difficult to get pregnant.

 Between 30-50% of women with endometriosis may experience infertility.
