## Preconception Care App Description

The Preconception Care mobile application (app) was developed by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and provides VA and non-VA care team members with information that supports the integration of preconception care into comprehensive primary care, thereby optimizing the health of women Veterans of reproductive age.

### ***Purpose and Background:***

Preconception care is well woman care for women of reproductive age. Health care team members caring for these women must take into consideration pregnancy intentions, medical conditions and use of contraception. Given the multi-faceted needs of these women, having access to relevant information is important. The Preconception Care app provides a single, easy access point for provider-centered resources that address a variety of factors, including birth control usage, reproductive history, health status, family and genetic history and risks, vaccinations received and lifestyle factors. The app also allows VA and non-VA care team members the opportunity to educate women Veterans about contraception and other health issues that can impact overall health during pregnancy.

The Preconception Care app was developed in collaboration with the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) office of Women's Health Services and is one of a series of VA apps developed as part of the Mobile Health Provider Program.



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## How Can This App Benefit Care Team Members?

- Review a healthy lifestyle checklist with patients that addresses topics such as alcohol, drug and tobacco use, intimate partner violence and vitamin guidelines.
- Find talking points to guide discussions on medical and mental health issues, general health concerns and risk factors specific to pre-pregnancy and pregnancy decisions.
- Share resources and evidence-based information with patients about services and programs from VA and other key organizations (e.g., Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Health and Human Services).
- Identify factors that may increase risk during a future pregnancy and identify preventative actions that can mitigate such risks.
- Develop a Reproductive Life Plan by referencing recommended questions to help guide discussions about planning for or preventing pregnancy.
