National Home for Disabled Volunteer Soldiers (VHA's predecessor) starts accepting women Veterans

**1946**

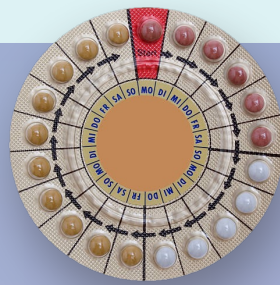
First 10 women doctors appointed to treat women Veterans

**1992**

Gender-specific services now offered, including Pap tests, breast exams, and birth control



**1988**

First VHA office created to address women's health issues



**2008**

VA providers specifically trained in women's health care, including cervical cancer screening and post-deployment care

**2010**

Newborn care now offered



**2012**

National Maternity Care Coordination Program established



**2010**

Women's health providers now available, making care more accessible

**2022**

Pregnancy options counseling and expanded reproductive health services become available
